Annual Meeting 2021

On July 9th, the 'Sconset Trust held our 36th Annual Meeting to a standing-room-only crowd. Highlights of the meeting included the election of new board members Barbara Bispham, Robert Franklin, Will Hannum and Bill Holding. Dave and Ben Champoux received our Preservation Award in recognition of their outstanding work developing the Heller Trail, as well as their continuing maintenance of our properties, including the Lighthouse grounds and Ruddick Commons. Retiring board members Lilo Cunningham, Kate Heller O'Reilly, Ellen Mitchell and Greg Garland were recognized for their service.

Eric Savetsky, retiring head of the Nantucket Land Bank, was honored with a 'Sconset Trust post award and commendation for his service to the island, especially his collaborative efforts in 'Sconset.

Land Update

The Land Committee was busy this year identifying and assessing potential land acquisitions for the Trust, while maintaining and improving our holdings. The most exciting development this year was the creation of the Heller Trail that runs through our 14.66 acre property just south of the Milestone, between Morey and Cannonbury lanes. This approximately 1-mile trail makes use of a longheld Trust property. The trail system allows for walks and also provides a connection between Morey Lane and Low Beach Road via Cannonbury Lane. We have to thank the

Heller family for donating the land to the Trust, our neighbors around Heller Trail for working with us, Ben Champoux for laying out and cutting the trails, and David Brown for doing the lion's share of the legal, planning, and public outreach work.

We would like your help to continue our mission of conservation and preservation. If you know of any large parcels of land or unique properties of historical or environmental significance that may be a good addition to our portfolio of holdings, please let us know.
